授業のテーマ

This course will provide a brief introduction to the area of international investment law and build on the framework knowledge imparted in the International Investment Law 1 course.

The course will examine major systems used to resolve investment disputes and key legal issues, with recent investor-State disputes as examples for class discussion. In particular, the course will focus on areas such as the following:

- Institutions and rules commonly used in Investor-State Dispute Settlement (ISDS) such as the ICSID system;
- Analysis of major legal issues raised in investment arbitration cases; and
- Major recent developments such as the Investment Court system being proposed by the EU.

The course will be interactive in nature, with the expectation that participants will read the recommended materials before class.

The materials will include actual treaty provisions (including those in Asia-specific agreements), selected investor-State arbitration cases and relevant cou
