Each participant has to contact with the host institution beforehand as to the jobs and activities during their stay there and to get the permission of the coordinators.

成績評価方法

- Report by the mentor of the host institution (80%)
- Report written by each participant as to their achievements during the period of internship (20%)

成績評価基準

Based on the above-mentioned method, the evaluation will be done in accordance with the level of objective achievement.

履修上の注意（関連科目情報）

The participants are requested to meet the coordinators and discuss about the feasibility of the plan at least two months before leaving Japan.
There are various institutions who are willing to accept the interns from Kobe University Law School. However, each institutions has some discretion to select the interns according to their preferable standards.
