Lesson topic

In recent years, governments around the world have negotiated a vast network of treaties designed to stimulate foreign investment. These treaties give substantial rights and protections to covered investors, and it is important for anyone involved in international business to be familiar with them. Meanwhile, the activities of multinational enterprises are increasingly attracting controversy because of their potential adverse impacts on the environment and local communities.

Lesson target

This seminar explores investment treaties and other international law governing the treatment and regulation of foreign investment, as well as the challenge of balancing the competing interests and goals implicated by foreign investment, including investor rights and protections, economic development, the sovereignty of host states, protection of the environment, and human rights. Consideration is also given to ICSID and dispute settlement mechanisms.
