授業のテーマと到達目標

XXth century has been marked with development of aviation, which has rapidly become one of the important modes of transportation of passengers and cargo. In the XXIst century the role of aviation in connecting different regions and countries of the world and resolving other civil and military tasks (humanitarian, search-and-rescue, military etc.) is also increasing. In view of truly universal scope of aviation international cooperation between States, organizations, airlines and other entities is crucial for its further safe and efficient functioning. Of course, such international cooperation cannot be achieved without establishment and development of the relevant legal principles and international legal framework governing the activities both of public and private players. Therefore, understanding the main elements of this international legal framework is of increasing importance for law school students, who plan to be involved in international law, external relations and international transactional business. The course is aimed to introduce to students major principles and mechanisms of international air law and their operation in practice.

授業の概要と計画

Twelve lectures covering international and regional legal framework setting the status of airspace and regulating aviation and air transport activities. These lectures include both public and private international law issues relating to aviation and air transportation and cover the following topics:

- I. Historical evolution of international air law
- II. Concept, system and main principles of international air law
- III. Legal regime of airspace and flights of aircraft
- IV. Legal status of aircraft and its crew
- V. International legal regime of air transportation
- VI. International legal measures against acts of unlawful interference with civil aviation
- VII. International aviation organizations and their impact on development of air law
- VIII. Unification of rules relating to international carriage by air
- IX. Liability for damage caused by foreign aircraft to third parties on the surface
- X. Some legal issues of inter-airline cooperation
