Students learn various aspects and recent development of Asian business law through the lectures given by leading academics, practitioners, and business persons from various jurisdictions in Asia including Japan.

Syllabus and plan

The program is scheduled from Aug 21 to Aug 25 as an intensive course. Four or five lectures will be delivered each day. Details of topics and lecturers will be announced soon. On Aug 25, moot international arbitration competition will be organized by the students.

Evaluation method

Attendance and class participation 50%; term paper (about 3000 words) 50%.
