Lesson topic

The purpose of these lectures will be to understand the interactions between Global Administrative Law (GAL) and International Law by taking an institutional perspective. GAL appeared in 2005, as the result of the combined work of researchers from American universities (mainly New York University School of Law) and Italian universities. GAL's purpose is to analyze a set of mechanisms, rules and procedures comparable to national administrative law used to promote transparency, increased participation, and the establishment of accountability mechanisms, within a hybrid structure (called Global Administrative Space), composed of both international organizations and non-state actors.
