#### Lesson topic

This seminar provides an overview of the work of international arbitration institutions and other international-dispute-resolution service providers in Asia. The operations of the participating institutions and courts will be considered with special attention paid to areas of specialization, innovations, and trends.

#### Lesson target

Participating students will gain insight into the role of participating institutions and courts. They will also become familiar with international arbitration and mediation procedures as well as the functioning of international commercial courts.

#### Syllabus and plan

Leaders from the various institutions will come to Kobe to give lectures. In the past, participating speakers have included managers and directors from international arbitration institutions including the China International Economic and Trade Arbitration Commission ( "CIETAC" ), the Hong Kong International Arbitration Center ( "HKIAC" ), the International Chamber of Commerce ( "ICC" ), the Japan Commercial Arbitration Association ( "JCAA" ), the Kuala Lumpur Regional Centre for Arbitration ( "KLRC" ), and the Singapore International Arbitration Centre ( "SIAC" ) as well as the Singapore International Commercial Court ( "SICC" ).

In the fall term of 2017, the seminar will take place on 4-5 November.

#### Evaluation method

The students will be assessed as follows:  
Seminar attendance and participation - 70%  
Paper - 30%
