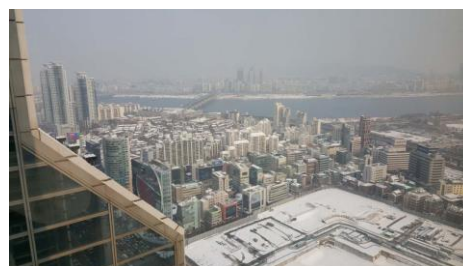
- 1) Details / 詳細
 - a) Research
