Lesson topic

The aim of this lecture is to give students an understanding of the international and interdisciplinary exchange of ideas between law, social sciences and biomedicine.

Lesson target

Students will be expected to understand and appreciate the complex relationships between legal, social and biomedical sciences.

Syllabus and plan

This course will be held as an intensive course: 29 (Fri) afternoon and 30 (Sat) morning, November 2024. Students will fully participate in the international conference entitled 'Globalisation and the Challenges for Healthcare/Public Health: Towards an International and Interdisciplinary Debate', after which they will be required to submit an essay written in English.

The specific theme of each session of the conference is yet to be confirmed, but possible themes are as follows:

Sessions 1~2: Global IP issues in the development of new drugs.

Session 3: The role of transnational law in the face of the inability of nation states to respond to the global spread of infectious diseases.

Session 4: Strategies for balancing the distribution of medical resources between economically advantaged and disadvantaged areas.

Session 5: Case studies of cultural conflicts over the provision of medical technologies and services

Sessions 6~7: Global Minimum for Healthcare

Students will be assessed by an essay, which may address a specific topic discussed at the conference. Full attendance at the conference is a requirement.

Evaluation baseline

The essay will be marked on the accuracy of your understanding of the relationships between law, biomedicine and global healthcare, and the depth of your analysis of the topic argued.
